

IAO Professional Advancement and Instructor Seminars

Dear Member:

We would like to invite you to attend the 2020 Professional Advancement and Instructor Course. These seminars are designed to enhance your clinical skills starting with collecting excellence records, proper diagnosis, proper interpretation, and plan appropriate treatment.

There will be four two-day sessions to help you achieve these goals. They will be held in Dallas-Fort Worth Airport, Texas. All sessions are two full days. The Second day will end around 5:00 PM on Saturday. Please keep this in mind when making travel arrangements. The Seminars are IAO sanctioned, taught by experienced IAO Diplomates and all proceeds will go directly to the IAO.

Session 1: May 15-16, 2020 - A review of obtaining good records and then using that information to develop a treatment plan that will be successful for you and your patient. Identifying things to be aware of to avoid unwanted outcomes. How to plan with the end in mind.

Session 2: June 26-27 - An introduction to Caseworx and Cephworx. Caseworx is the software, all members have free access to, that will help to organize your records and data in a useful format for presentation. Also, using Caseworx to prepare for Professional Advancement in the IAO will be discussed. Cephworx is an electronic cephalometric tracing program. The software is included with the registration for all attendees of the second session. The program is a value of \$1495.

Session 3: August 21-22, 2020 - This session will focus on mechanics and treatments that will guide you to successful orthodontic outcomes in your office. Every case is different, and as such each one has a best treatment plan option. The purpose of the third session is to help introduce new modalities that attendees may not have been exposed to before. This will help build out the foundation of orthodontic treatments which participants may offer in their practice to best serve their patients.

Session 4: November 6-7, 2020 - This session will assist you in moving forward in your orthodontic career including the possibility of becoming a mentor to pass on the knowledge you have obtained. The purpose is to align candidates with the requirements of becoming an IAO Certified Instructor.

After course completion, will assist you in promoting your professional advancement through Fellowship and Diplomate status, and aid you in achieving Certified IAO Instructor status.
